Category
Door-to-Door HHW: Curbside recycling of Household Hazardous Waste for Senior/Disabled CMSD residents
Commodities: includes waste (paper, wood, metal, etc...) collected by CR&R
White Goods: includes large bulky items collected from CMSD residents.
Sharps: Sharps and needles that are collected and safely disposed of at designated areas.
Pharmaceuticals: Used medication that is collected and safely disposed of at designated areas.
Christmas Trees: Trees that are collected and recycled into mulch.
Telephone Books: Comprehensive telephone directories collected and diverted from landfills.
Alkaline Batteries: Household batteries collected from participant schools.
HHW: Biennial collection event that diverts hazardous household waste.
